- The preparation of a Conservation Management Plan in accordance with the *Australia ICOMOS Charter for Places of Cultural Significance 2013 (The Burra Charter)* and the Heritage Council of Victoria's *Conservation Management Plans: Managing Heritage Places A Guide (2010).*
- For development affecting significant vegetation (as listed in the Schedule to the Heritage Overlay), the preparation of an arboricultural report that addresses the significance, integrity and condition of the vegetation and the potential impacts.
- For any applications for partial demolition, the provision of a demolition method statement that details how retained fabric is to be safeguarded during demolition and construction.
- For any proposal to relocate a heritage place, the preparation of a structural engineering report indicating the relocation methodology to ensure the structural and physical integrity of the fabric.
- For applications for additions above heritage buildings, the preparation of viewline diagrams.
