

GLASS-ONLY

Empty glass bottles and jars without lids go into the bin with the purple lid. Collars and labels may stay on.



All clear and coloured glass bottles and jars, empty and without lids, such as:

- ✓ Beer bottles
- ✓ Wine bottles
- ✓ Champagne bottles
- ✓ Other drink bottles
- ✓ Condiment bottles
- ✓ Jam jars
- ✓ Pasta sauce jars
- ✓ Other food jars
- ✓ Beauty product jars
- ✓ Vitamin bottles
- ✓ Medicine jars
- ✓ Labels and metal collars may be left on

NO: mirrors, light globes, crockery, window glass, pyrex, ceramics, or drinking glasses - these go in the landfill bin.

NO: cardboard boxes (like beer cartons) - these go in the recycling bin.



Glass does not go in the co-mingled recycling bin with the yellow lid. Never put plastic bags or other plastic packaging in the glass bin. **Aluminium lids from wine bottles should be removed and placed in the landfill bin.** Metal beer bottle lids should be removed and placed into the recycle bin. **Make sure bottles and jars are empty.**
