General household waste that can't go in one of the other bins goes in the bin with the red lid. Please don't include recyclables, e-waste, or food waste.

General waste that goes in this bin ends up in landfill, so it's a good idea to avoid putting things in there when you can. E-waste (that's anything with a plug or battery) is not allowed in landfills in Victoria and should be taken to a transfer station for free drop-off. Any bags or extra waste sitting beside kerbside bins won't be collected.
