

Kerbside collections through 30 January 2021

Even though we have delivered everything you need to get started with the FOGO service and the glass-only bin, the new service doesn't start until 1 February 2021. Don't put your food waste in your green bin before then (unless you are in Anglesea), and while you are welcome to add glass bottles and jars to the glass-only bin, it won't get picked up until February.

Here's a reminder about what goes in the kerbside bins now:



Empty rigid plastic containers
with numbers 1 to 5 only



Empty steel food cans, aluminium cans and foil



Empty glass bottles and jars.
Place metal lids in the recycling bin separately



Clean paper and cardboard

RECYCLING BIN



DON'T bag it.
Recycling must go in loose!



No soft plastic packaging like bread bags chip packets etc.



No small plastic lids



No coated cardboard cartons used to package milk and other liquids

- ✓ **Grass, leaves, twigs, flowers**
- ✓ **Small branches**
under 30cm long and 10cm wide
- ✓ **Weeds**
- ✓ **Anglesea households** can continue adding all food waste



- ✓ **General household waste**
that can't go in the recycling or organics bins, like fabric, personal items, polystyrene and more
- ✓ **Nappies**
- ✓ **Plastic bags**
or take to a Redcycle drop off



ORGANICS BIN

- ✗ **Garbage and recyclables**
Put these in the landfill or recycling bin
- ✗ **Plastic bags**
Put these in the landfill bin or take to a Redcycle drop off
- ✗ **Food waste**
unless you are in Anglesea

LANDFILL BIN

- ✗ **Hazardous materials**
- ✗ **Recyclables or garden waste**
Put these in the recycling or organics bin
- ✗ **E-waste**
Any item with a plug, battery or power cord needs to be taken to the transfer station
