



Merrijig Drive and Fischer Street roundabout

Works Schedule: Start: Monday 17 June

Planned finish: Friday 21 June

Earlier in the year we told you about our plans to construct a roundabout at the intersection of Merrijig Drive and Fischer Street.

Our contractor is now ready to start on Monday 17 June.

The works will be completed as quickly as possible to keep disruption to a minimum, which means the intersection will be closed to traffic for the week commencing 17 June.

Local residents will still be able to access their properties at all times, although there may be short delays at some times.

Through traffic will be diverted along Centreside Drive, with access to the shopping centre via Manuka Street and Beachley Lane. Residents on detour routes can expect temporary increased traffic for the week.

You should put your bin out as normal and leave them until collected, unless advised otherwise.

- The new roundabout will improve traffic flow and increase safety
- Works will be concentrated into one week to reduce impact
- The Merrijig Drive / Fischer Street intersection will be closed during works
- Local access will be maintained throughout the works
- Diversion routes will experience more traffic for one week only
- The roundabout will be mountable to allow large vehicles to turn safely

Roundabout Design

The roundabout and two sections of kerb will feature a mountable design, which will enable large vehicles and trucks to manoeuvre safely through the intersection.

Works will also include construction of pedestrian crossing refuges, a new accessible car parking space, new kerb and channel and all associated line marking.
