

ENTRY DETAILS AND ELIGIBILITY

- Artists must be a resident or ratepayer of the Surf Coast Shire.
- Artists who have been selected for the calendar in the last two years are NOT ELIGIBLE to enter.
- The winning entries will receive a prize of \$300, with limited copyright requirements.
- All winning entries remain the property of the artist (or owner).

This is a Community Calendar. There is no theme. The Selection Panel is looking for:

- Diversity (of artform and artist)
- Innovation
- Representation - the Surf Coast Shire Calendar competition encourages people of All Abilities to enter.
- Young people are encouraged to submit work.

CATEGORIES

Thirteen artworks will be selected from two categories:

Open - all media (including 2D, 3D, painting, ceramics, textiles etc.)

Installed Art Work (art which has been installed in Public/Private spaces). If the work is owned by a party other than the artist, BOTH parties must sign the entry form. Photographic images will be accepted for this category only. Please upload as a jpeg with your entry. Please Note: Site visits for professional photographing of the work may be required *for the calendar*.

JUDGING PROCESS

All entries will be judged at the start of the exhibition. Twelve works will be selected by a Panel for the Calendar.

The decision of the judging panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

A "People's Choice" category will decide the Community Arts Calendar cover.

The artwork will be voted by the community as the most popular from the remaining works.

The "People's Choice" voting will take place during the exhibition period and will be determined at the close of the exhibition.

The winners will be contacted by email and the announced via the media.

All winning entries will be awarded \$300

ARTIST REQUIREMENTS

- Artists may enter one work only
- The work must be ready to hang—work may not be accepted if it is not able to be easily displayed.
- Works must be submitted and collected as per the timeline below.
- Works must clearly show the title, artist's name, address, email and contact number.

TIMELINE

Works must be submitted for exhibition: from 12 – 6pm, Thursday 17 October

- **Exhibition opens:** 6pm Friday 18 October
- **Exhibition closes:** 5pm Sunday 3 November
- **Bump Out:** 12-6pm Monday 4 November

PROMOTION AND PUBLICITY

Calendar promotion is the responsibility of the Surf Coast Shire and may involve the co-operation of the artists in photographic opportunities etc.

COPYRIGHT

The winning artists agree to permit Surf Coast Shire Council to publish reproductions of the work for any non-commercial purpose, including Council cards, brochures, tourist information, promotional posters, catalogues and documentary film for a period of two years from selection.

PRODUCTION OF THE WORK

The artist will ensure that the work is original and produced with all due professional artistic skill, quality and craftsmanship.

EXHIBITION

The Exhibition period will be from Friday 18 October to Sunday 3 September.

REPRODUCTION OF THE WINNING WORKS.

Council will engage a professional photographer to photograph the winning works for the calendar.

The exception to this is if the winning work is a photograph or an installed artwork - the artist will then be required to provide a jpg.
