

### ENTRY DETAILS

- Artists must be a resident or ratepayer of the Surf Coast Shire.
- Artists who have been selected for the calendar in the last two years are NOT ELIGIBLE to enter.
- The winning entries will receive a prize of \$300, with limited copyright requirements.
- All winning entries remain the property of the artist (or owner).

This is a Community Calendar. To reflect the extraordinary nature of 2020, this year's Calendar Competition will be held ONLINE from Friday 16 October – Friday 30 October via #Portal, and entries must work with the theme The World at Home.

Works should reflect the artist's life during 2020 - whether created in response to Lockdown or reflecting the things that kept you buoyed throughout the time.

### CATEGORIES

Thirteen artworks will be selected.

All entries must be photographed and submitted as jpeg files.

•All winning works must then be made available for professional photography according to COVID restrictions in place at the time.

### ELIGIBILITY

1. Artists who live or pay rates in Surf Coast Shire are encouraged to enter.
2. Artists can submit one entry only.
3. If your work has appeared in the calendar in the last two years, you are not eligible to enter.

There are three categories:

- Open (all media)
- Installed Sculptural Work
- Children/Youth

### JUDGING PROCESS

All entries will be judged at the start of the exhibition. Twelve works will be selected by a Panel for the Calendar.

The decision of the judging panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

A "People's Choice" category will decide the Community Arts Calendar cover.

The artwork will be voted by the community as the most popular from the remaining works.

The "People's Choice" voting will take place during the digital exhibition period and will be determined at the close of the exhibition.

The winners will be contacted by email and announced via the media.

All winning entries will be awarded \$300

### ARTIST REQUIREMENTS

- Artists may enter one work only
- Works must be submitted via jpeg file.
- Works must clearly show the artist's name, address, email and contact number.

### TIMELINE

- Entries open: 9am Wednesday 19 August
- Entries close 5pm Friday 25 September (no late entries will be accepted)
- Exhibition Dates: Friday 16 – 30 October

### EXHIBITION

The Exhibition period will be from Friday 16 October to Friday 30 October 2020, via #PORTAL ([surfcoastartstrail.com.au](http://surfcoastartstrail.com.au)).

### REPRODUCTION OF THE WINNING WORKS.

Council will engage a professional photographer to photograph the winning works for the calendar.

### PROMOTION AND PUBLICITY

Calendar promotion is the responsibility of the Surf Coast Shire and may involve the co-operation of the artists in photographic opportunities etc.

### COPYRIGHT

The winning artists agree to permit Surf Coast Shire Council to publish reproductions of the work for any non-commercial purpose, including Council cards, brochures, tourist information, promotional posters, catalogues and documentary film for a period of two years from selection.

### PRODUCTION OF THE WORK

The artist will ensure that the work is original and produced with all due professional artistic skill, quality and craftsmanship.
