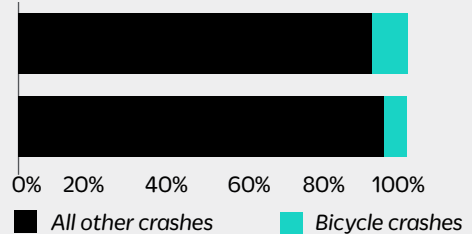

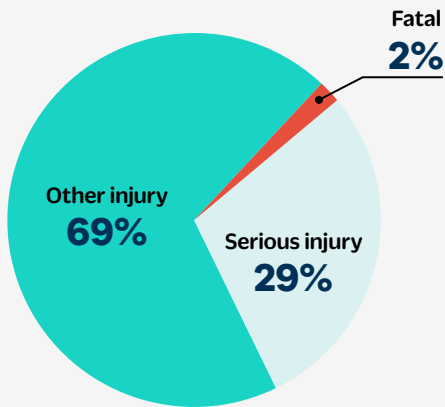

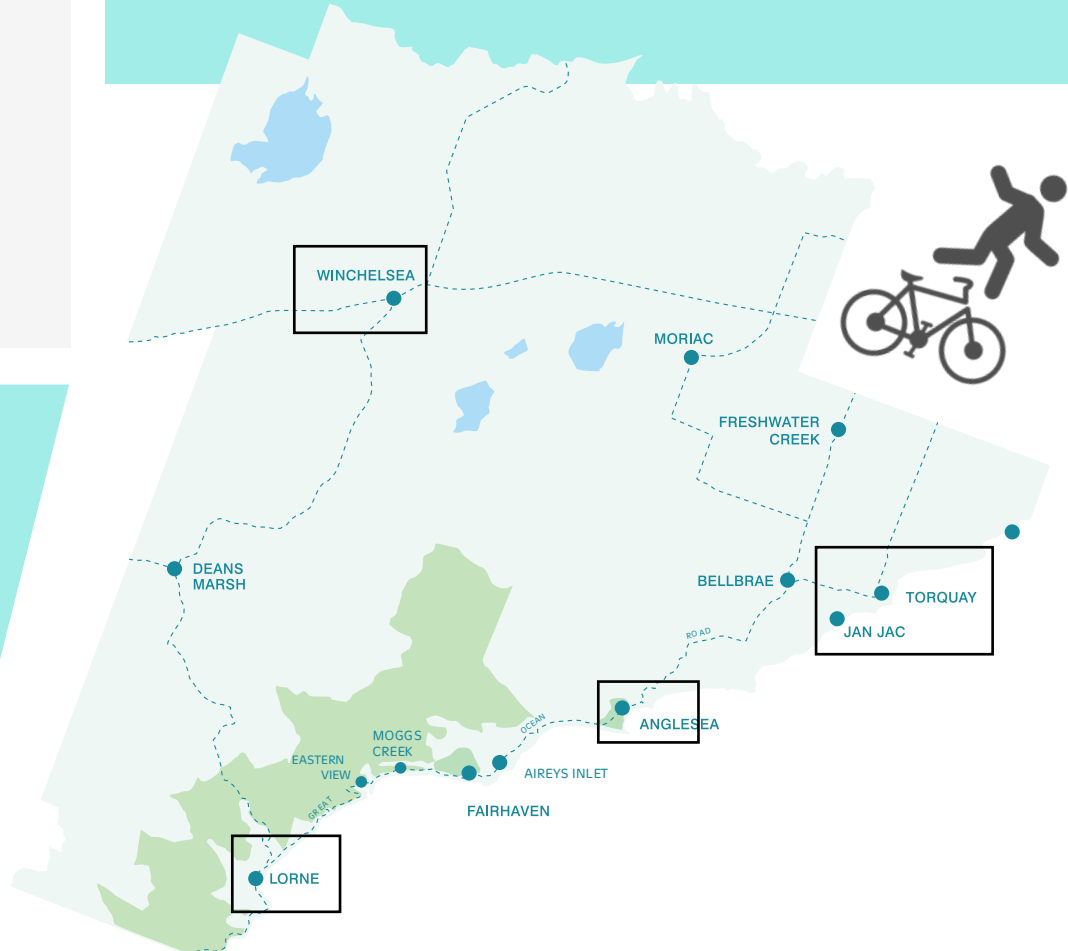

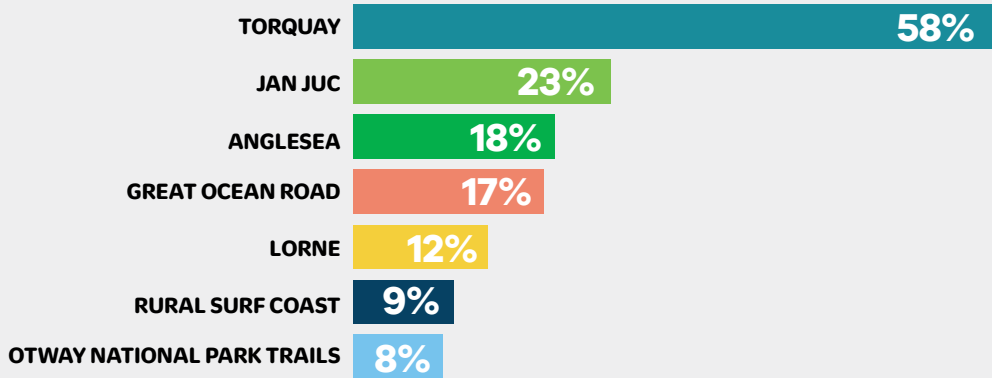

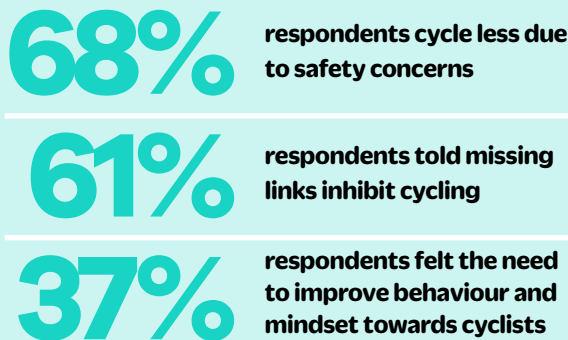


Cyclist crash patterns identified on the Great Ocean Road, Horseshoe Bend Road, Bell Street and Fischer Street

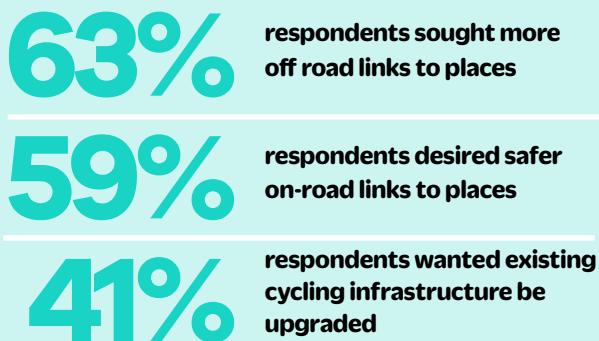
COMMON CYCLING LOCATIONS

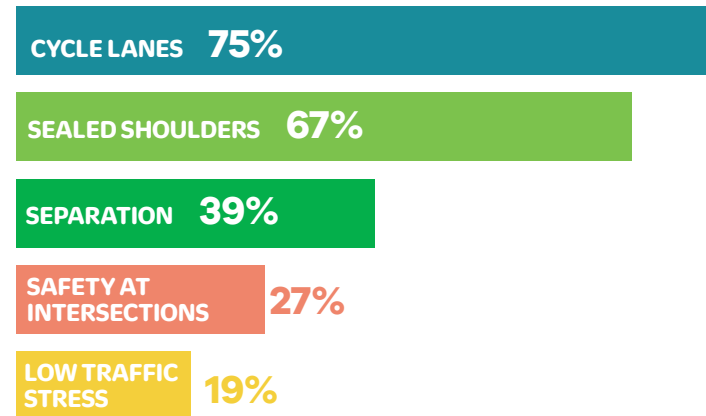

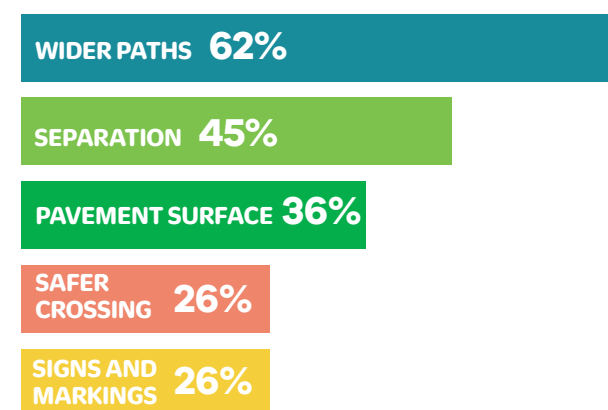

ON-ROAD



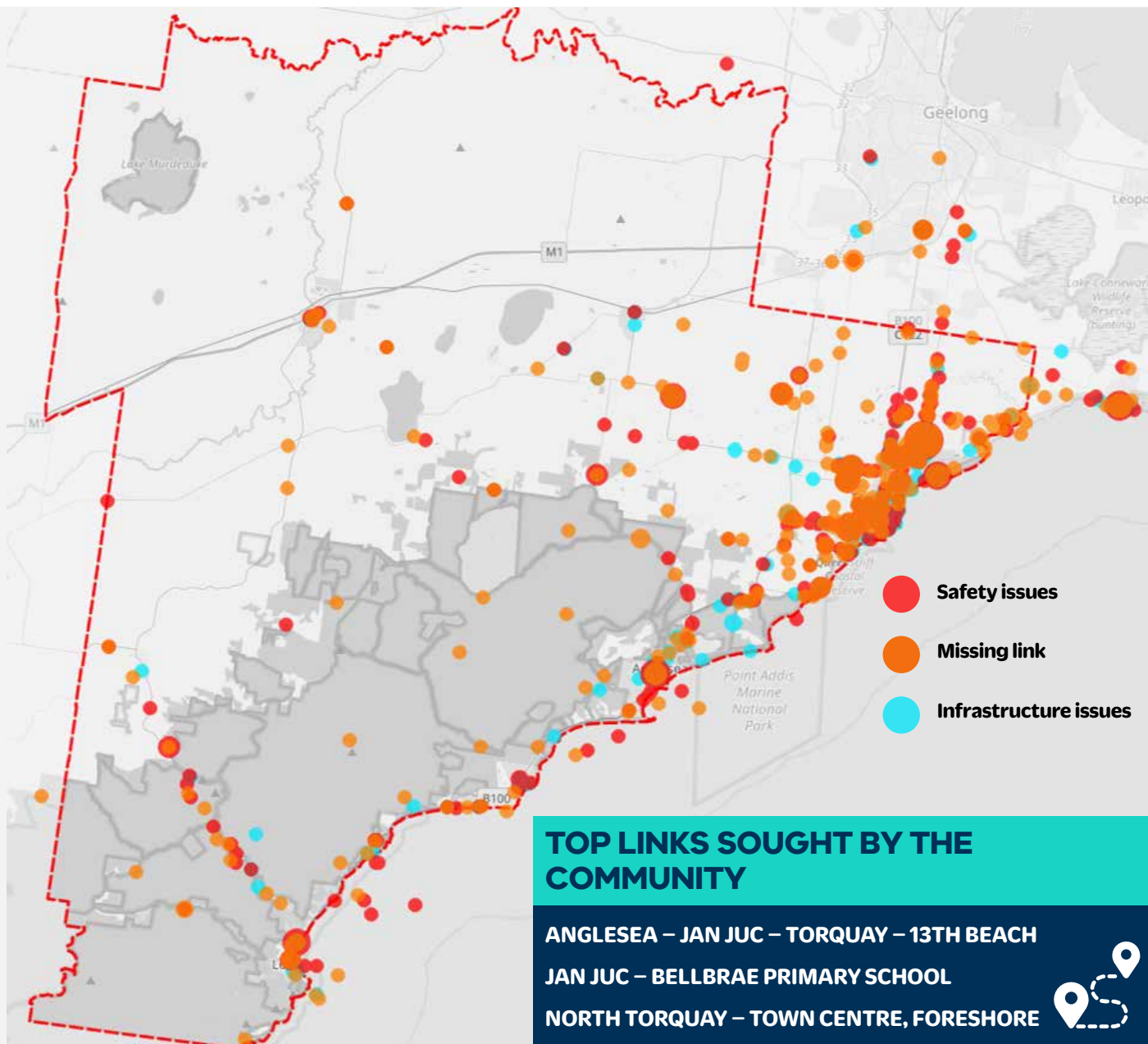

EMERGING THEMES AND ISSUES INFORMED BY THE COMMUNITY, STAKEHOLDERS AND CRASH ANALYSIS

1 CONNECTED CYCLING NETWORK

Missing links, limited on and off-road cycling options and crossings across main roads

2 CYCLING INFRASTRUCTURE

Limited allocated space, conflicts between users and lack of purpose-to-fit facilities

3 MAINTENANCE

Rough shoulders, unstable verges and unsuitable road / path surface

4 CYCLING TO SCHOOL

Lack of safer crossings, poor driver and parking behaviour, conflicts with walkers and desire for direct routes

5 EDUCATION, PROMOTION AND COLLABORATION

Car culture, negative attitude and lack of awareness of Road Rules

6 SUPPORT INFRASTRUCTURE AND AMENITY

Need for more cycle racks, drinking taps, wayfinding and cycling hubs

7 EVENTS AND TOURISM CYCLING

Need to improve access to events, traffic management and community tolerance

8 EFFECTIVE AND INTEGRATED PLANNING

Need more integrated planning for developments and a clear guide on future cycling links
