Last year, we asked you to change how you sorted your household waste and recycling.

Your efforts during the past 12 months have helped save a total **13,055 TONNES** of waste from landfill.

ONLY 5290 TONNES OF WASTE WAS SENT TO LANDFILL FROM OUR KERBSIDE BINS.

Even with recent increases in our population, that's the lowest amount since 2013/14.

And our contamination rates (that's items in the wrong bin) are some of the lowest in the region, with less than 1% contamination in our Food Organics and Garden Organics (FOGO) and glass-only bins.

We are also recycling more than ever through our transfer stations. In the past 12 months we have collected;

- **83 TONNES OF E-WASTE**(that's electrical appliances and electronic devices)
- 51 TONNES OF GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS
