Instrument of Delegation (Child Wellbeing and Safety Act 2005)

By this Instrument of Delegation, in exercise of the power conferred by s 46L of the *Child Wellbeing and Safety Act* 2005 (Act) I, as the Chief Executive Officer of Surf Coast Shire Council:
