

LANDFILL

General household waste that can't go in one of the other bins goes in the bin with the red lid. Please don't include recyclables, e-waste, or food waste.



- ✓ Crockery, drinking glasses, ceramics, and Pyrex
- ✓ Mirrors
- ✓ Plastic bags, garbage bags, clingwrap and other soft plastic packaging (or take these to a REDcycle collection point).
- ✓ Takeaway coffee cups
- ✓ Coffee pods
- ✓ Blister packs (medicine)
- ✓ Foam, including meat trays, cups and packaging
- ✓ Cooking oil (in bottle or container)
- ✓ Used dish cloths and sponges
- ✓ Nappies (including compostable)
- ✓ Baby wipes
- ✓ Tissues
- ✓ Band-aids
- ✓ Disposable razors
- ✓ Cotton buds/balls and makeup remover pads
- ✓ Dental floss, toothbrushes
- ✓ Long life milk and juice cartons
- ✓ Other waxed cardboard
- ✓ Plastics with the numbers 3, 4, 6 or 7
- ✓ Sanitary and incontinence products
- ✓ Rags, clothing and shoes that cannot be repaired or reused
- ✓ Video tapes, CDs and DVDs
- ✓ Ropes, hoses and strapping



General waste that goes in this bin ends up in landfill, so it's a good idea to avoid putting things in there when you can. E-waste (that's anything with a plug or battery) is not allowed in landfills in Victoria and should be taken to a transfer station for free drop-off. **Any bags or extra waste sitting beside kerbside bins won't be collected.**
