RECYCLING

Empty plastic containers, paper, cardboard, and metals go in the bin with the yellow lid. Never put plastic bags or soft plastic packaging in the recycling bin - items should go in loose.

Recycling must go in the bin loose. Never put plastic bags or soft plastic packaging in this bin. **Small plastic lids (like from milk or juice cartons) should be removed and placed in the landfill bin.** Metal beer bottle lids can go into the recycle bin, but aluminium wine caps can't. **Empty all containers and remove lids.** No need to wash items, just scrape them clean.
