## Food Organics and Garden\* Organics



All food waste, which includes, raw, cooked, leftover, and spoilt, goes in the kerbside bin with the lime green lid.

- ✓ Baked goods
- ✓ Bones (no large dog bones)
- ✓ Bread
- ✓ Cakes and pastries
- ✓ Cereal slops
- ✓ Cereals and grains
- ✓ Cream
- ✓ Cheese
- ✓ Chocolate
- ✓ Citrus
- ✓ Coffee grounds and filter paper (no pods)
- ✓ Dairy products
- ✓ Egg and eggshells
- ✓ Flour
- ✓ Food scraps
- ✓ Fruit (whole, scraps, or peelings)
- ✓ Grains and legumes
- ✓ Hair - human and pet
- ✓ Jelly
- ✓ Leftover food
- ✓ Lollies
- ✓ Meat - raw, cooked, and scraps
- ✓ Nuts and seeds
- ✓ Onion
- ✓ Out of date food (no packaging)
- ✓ Pasta
- ✓ Rice
- ✓ Salad and dressing
- ✓ Seafood including bones and shells
- ✓ Spoiled food
- ✓ Take away food
- ✓ Tea leaves
- ✓ Vegetables (whole, scraps, or peelings)
- ✓ Yoghurt

\*The FOGO bin is also used for lawn clippings, leaves, twigs and small branches.



Use the kitchen caddy to collect food in the kitchen and transfer to the kerbside bin with the lime green lid. You can use a supplied compostable liner, or just add items in loose. **Never put plastic bags or packaging in the FOGO bin.** Organics in the FOGO bin are composted and used on farms, parks and gardens.
