# 1. Membership

# 2. Pickleball Australia, Pickleball Victoria and Torquay Pickleball Membership

Register and pay the appropriate fee via the Pickleball Victoria website (link below). The fees for Pickleball Australia, Pickleball Victoria and Torquay Pickleball are all paid with the one payment.

Total Fees: Adult = \$80, Senior (Over 65) and Junior (Under 18) = \$70

# 4. Registering for sessions.

We use the Spond electronic booking system to register & pay for sessions. This can be done by using the Spond App.

## **Process:**

1. Download the Spond App from the App Store

- 3. Sign up to sessions
- 4. Register your credit card with Spond to pay session fees

## 5. Equipment.



## 7. Pickleball Basics

Here's some information to help you get started on the court:

Pickleball is a paddle sport played with a whiffle ball on a badminton size court.







### Some Rules You Should Know:

- The serve Must be Underhand and land crosscourt into the opposite serving area, (the area between the baseline and the Non-Volley Zone).
- Both the Serve and the Return of Serve **Must Bounce**. This means the serving team must not volley the return of serve.
- The First Side to Serve (Doubles) **Has One Serve**; **Then, Each Side Has Two.** The serving sequence always begins in the right hand service box.
- In Doubles The Server Calls the Score Before Each Serve. The first number is the serving teams score, the second number the receiving teams score and the third number the server (1 or 2). So, if the score is 5- 3-2 the  $1^{st}$  number (5) = the serving teams score, the  $2^{nd}$  (3) = the receiving teams score and the  $3^{rd}$  number (2) = the server  $(1^{st}$  or  $2^{nd}$ ).
- Only the Serving Team Can Score Points, the serving team switches sides after each point won. Games to 11 points (win by 2)
- No Volleys Are Allowed in the Non-Volley Zone (also known as the Kitchen) both at the time of contact with the ball and after contact if your momentum carries you into the Non-Volley Zone.
- You can play a shot in the non-volley zone **if the ball has bounced**.
- Shots that hit the lines are in, **except** a serve that hits a line bordering the Non Volley Zone. This is a fault.
