

Summer Flowers of Anglesea & Aireys Inlet

Sweet Bursaria

Bursaria spinosa subsp. spinosa



Prickly woody shrub to 2m or more, with small oval leaves. Masses of fragrant, creamy-white, five petalled flowers. Popular with bees and butterflies.

Moonah

Melaleuca lanceolata



Dense erect or small tree with short narrow, thick dull-green leaves. Clusters of highly perfumed, creamy-white 'bottle-brush' flowers.

Dusty Daisy-bush

Olearia phlogopappa



Shrub of moist forests to 2m, with narrow, oval-shaped grey-green leaves. Clusters of yellow-centred, small white daisy-like flowers.

White Correa

Correa alba var. alba



Dense spreading coastal shrub, about 1.5 m, with oval grey-green leaves. White waxy flowers with spreading petals.

Twiggy Daisy-bush

Olearia ramulosa



Twiggy shrub, about 1m, with fine bright-green leaves. Masses of small white daisy flowers.

Anglesea: B, C, D, F Aireys Inlet: L

Blue Pincushion

Brunonia australis



Perennial herb to 20cm with basal rosettes of long, narrow, hairy spoonshaped leaves. Several flower bearing stems, each with one intensely blue dome-shaped flower-head,

with numerous yellow styles forming the pins in the 'pincushions'.

Ixodia

Ixodia archillaeoides subsp.alata



A late summer upright shrub to 1m, with narrow sticky green leaves. Clusters of vivid white papery flowers.


Rosy Hyacinth Orchid

Leafless, relatively tall orchid to 90 cm with thick brownish, occasionally green stem. Numerous stalked bright pink flowers.
