GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS ONLY



Empty all bottles and scrape jars to remove food residue. Metal collars and paper labels can stay on. Remove all lids.

Yes – put these in the GLASS bin

- ✓ Beer bottles
- ✓ Champagne bottles
- ✓ Coloured bottles e.g. amber, green
- ✓ Condiment jars eg Dijon, wholegrain mustard etc
- ✓ Crushed ginger & garlic jars
- ✓ Instant coffee jars
- ✓ Jam & honey jars
- ✓ Mayonnaise jars
- ✓ Olive oil bottles
- ✓ Pasta sauce jars
- ✓ Sauce bottles
- ✓ Soft drink & juice bottles
- ✓ Spice bottles
- ✓ Spirits bottles
- ✓ Vitamin bottles
- ✓ Wine bottles

No – leave these out of your GLASS bin

- ✗ Aluminium cans
- ✗ Bags of rubbish
- ✗ Cardboard boxes
- ✗ Crockery & ceramics
- ✗ Drinking glasses (broken or whole)
- ✗ Jar lids, bottle caps, corks
- ✗ Light globes
- ✗ Mirrors
- ✗ Perfume bottles
- ✗ Plastic bags
- ✗ Plastic bottles
- ✗ Plastic lids
- ✗ Pyrex cookware
- ✗ Vases



Remove all lids and place them in the yellow-lid recycling bin. Put glass bottles and jars in loose — not in plastic bags or cardboard boxes. Broken bottles and jars are accepted, but broken drinking glasses and wine glasses are not.

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
